WHAT IS A PHOTO STATION?

MyCoast: New Jersey Photo Stations are found in diverse locations along New Jersey's coast, where shorelines are constantly changing due to higher tides, more intense storms, and frequent erosion. By using a MyCoast Photo Station, you are documenting important impacts to your community's shoreline over time.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Scan the QR code on the sign or select your location on the MyCoast App. Take a photo of the shoreline using the phone holder. MyCoast fetches background data on weather and tide levels to add context to your photo. Your photo turns into data that helps us better understand our changing shorelines and manage our communities' life on the coast.

WHERE TO FIND MYCOAST PHOTO STATIONS



LIBERTY STATE PARK: Cherry Tree Cove

1 Audrey Zapp Drive, Jersey City, NJ 07305

Exit 14B on the NJ Turnpike, follow the signs into the park. You may use parking lot 9 (Empty Sky Memorial) or 10 (Marina/Restaurants). Walk to Cherry Tree Cove (Area N) and find a photo station on the railing facing the NYC skyline.



CHEESEQUAKE STATE PARK: Crabbing Bridge

Park entrance fees may be in effect at this location

300 Gordon Road, Matawan, NJ 07747

Exit 120 on Garden State Parkway to Matawan Rd, turn right on Morristown Rd, right onto Gordon Rd. Park entrance on the left. Access crabbing bridge by a boardwalk located near the Hooks Creek Lake Day Use Area parking lot, you will find a photo station on the left side of the bridge railing.



ISLAND BEACH STATE PARK: Fisherman's Walkway

Park entrance fees will be in effect, and may close at full capacity

2401 Central Ave, Seaside Park, NJ 08752

Exit 82 on Garden State Parkway to Route 37 east. Take Route 35 south to the park entrance. Drive approximately 5 miles to Parking Lot A-7. Fisherman's Walkway Trail (0.3 miles) is an ADA boardwalk trail takes you towards the ocean. You will find a photo station on the left side at the end of the boardwalk.



ISLAND BEACH STATE PARK: Johnny Allen's Cove

Park entrance fees will be in effect, and may close at full capacity

2401 Central Ave, Seaside Park, NJ 08752

Exit 82 on Garden State Parkway to Route 37 east. Take Route 35 south to the park entrance. Drive approximately 7 miles to Parking Lot A-16. The bayside trail starts across from the Interpretive Center and cuts through the thicket and freshwater wetland before it reaches Barnegat Bay, where you will find a photo station on the left.



MARGATE CITY: Fishing Pier

Beach entrance fees may be in effect at this location

121 S Exeter Ave, Margate City, NJ 08402

Exit 36 on Garden State Parkway, drive County Hwy 563 to continue onto E Mill Rd, over the toll bridge. Turn left on Ventnor Ave, turn right onto S Franklin Ave. Left on Atlantic Ave, first right onto S Exeter Ave. Minimal parking in this area, it is best to find street parking nearby. Public access to the pier is located on the beach by walking up the stairs, the photo station is affixed to the pier railing.



CAPE MAY POINT STATE PARK: Beach Walk

305 County Hwy 629, Cape May, NJ 08212

Exit 0 on Garden State Parkway S, keep straight onto State Highway 109. Bear right onto Jackson St, keep straight to stay on W Perry St. Road changes to Sunset Blvd (County Road 606). Turn left onto Light House Ave. Drive approx. 1 mile then turn left into the State Park. The photo station is located on the ADA beach entrance next to the nature center.
